Good Faith Network

Over the last three years we have held listening sessions for Good Faith Network. In 2025, we are renaming it and calling our community gatherings "Good Neighbor Conversations." We will reflect on what it means to be a good neighbor plus live in community. You may ask, "Why this emphasis on living in community?" Research that began in the mid-1990's shows that living in community, like social clubs, service clubs, bowling leagues,

bridge clubs, and church attendance has decreased by 50%. At the same time, people holding leadership roles in these kinds of community organizations has shrunk by 50%. This change is causing polarization and harm to democracy. It is a good time for us to gather together and talk about what it looks like to Love Our Neighbor and rebuild our community.
