Food Pantry Volunteers Needed

The food pantry team is in need of the following volunteers:

- Two people (they could alternate) to be responsible for sorting Costco produce. The food from Costco arrives twice a month and the shelf stable produce is placed on the kitchen counter. We need someone to sort out the bad and bag the rest as needed. This can be done on Sunday, Monday or Tuesday. This would be ongoing.
- Two people for the Harvesters food receiving team. This occurs on Monday or Tuesday before the second distribution Thursday each month. The ability to lift 20 pounds is required.

The Food Pantry is a vital ministry of FCC Olathe so we hope you'll consider volunteering.
